Why Give Through the MCC

The Maryland Charity Campaign (MCC) provides an opportunity to touch the lives of those in need; to sustain local, state, national, and international health, educational, environmental, and human service organizations, to name a few types of charities; and to make a meaningful contribution to your community. And the MCC is so much more:

- The MCC provides a single, coordinated appeal, rather than hundreds of individual drives.
- The MCC is the way for State employees and retirees to participate in the effort to meet local, national, and international causes that mean the most to them.
- More than 700 charities are eligible for donations.
- Pledge now and pay in 2027. Payroll deductions make it easier to afford a more generous gift, allowing donors to make smaller contributions from each paycheck.
- Charities that receive MCC donations may devote their MCC funds to areas where they are needed most. That's a value-add for the donor *and* the charity.
- Donations are aggregated before they are disbursed to charities, significantly reducing the administrative burden on designated charities, which will not be burdened by processing thousands of potential individual donations. The Campaign uses a state-of-the-art workplace and employee giving platform designed with Maryland's employees in mind and is intuitive and user-friendly.

Step 1: Login

- To get started, visit <https://mcc.maryland.gov> and click “Give Now” button. You will be redirected to the online giving portal for the Maryland Charity Campaign (MCC).
- Most employees will be able to login using Single Sign-on (SSO) using their existing Maryland work account. Those in agencies whose IT systems are not supported by DoIT, you will need to create a new account within the platform. Please refer to the agencies listed to determine which login method you should use.

- This will narrow the listing charities from the database to the specific charity you want to support, or a smaller list of organizations that meet your search criteria.
- Click on the Donate Now button next to a charity to begin the donation process.

Step 4: Enter Donation Amount

- After you have added a charity to your cart select your payment method from the dropdown menu.
- Enter the amount you want to donate in the Pledge Amount field.
- If you are giving via recurring payroll deduction, the amount you enter should be the amount deducted per payroll period (not the overall lump-sum total amount). Your pay period schedule is set by your employer and will be shown to you in the cart.
- If you are giving via ACH or credit card the amount you enter should be the total lump sum donation you wish to make.
- Decide whether or not you would like to share your contact information with the charity.
- Click the checkbox to confirm that you’ve made your pledge freely and that no goods or services will be received for your charitable gift.
- If you would like to give in honor of a loved one or indicate a specific funds program enter that information in the “Designate your gift” field.
- Click “Add to Cart.”
- Continue adding charities you would like to support using that payment method. Once you’ve added all of those charities to your cart, click the shopping cart icon in the upper right-hand corner of your screen and select “Proceed to Checkout”

Designate your gift

- The platform will automatically calculate your total annual donation amount based on the method you select. Click “Remove” to delete a charity from your cart, or if you would like to modify your donation amount, click “Edit” under the charity name, enter the updated amount you want to give, click Apply Changes to save that new amount. Click **“Proceed to Payment”** when you are ready to move to the final step, a summary of your order.
- In the final step, an order summary will display all charities, donation totals, and the payment method you have entered. When you are ready to submit your donation for processing, click the “Confirm Order” button. If you want to cancel your order and start over click Back to Order and then you will have the option to Cancel Your Order. **If you would like to change your payment method, you must cancel your order and start over.**

NOTE: Donations are voluntary and non-refundable.

Credit Card and ACH Donations: Once a credit card or ACH donation has been submitted, it cannot be canceled, refunded, or returned. Donors should review their contribution carefully before completing their donation.

Payroll: Requests received before payroll deductions are transmitted for processing may be eligible for adjustment. Once a payroll deduction has been processed by the employer and remitted to America’s Charities, the contribution is considered a completed charitable gift and is generally non-refundable.

- **Credit card**

- A credit card donation is a one-time, lump-sum amount. Credit-card transactions are processed immediately. Credit card donations are subject to a variable 2.9% + \$0.30 transaction fee. Actual processing fees vary based on factors such as card type, issuing bank, transaction method, and whether the card is a domestic or international card.

- **ACH**

- An ACH Debit/Electronic Check donation is a one-time, lump sum amount. ACH/eCheck transactions are processed immediately. All ACH/eCheck donations will incur a per transaction fee of 0.8% (with a \$5 cap) collected by your bank.
- In the Bank Account search box, enter the name of your bank and you should see it display as an option to select. Our funds management partner, America's Charities, uses Stripe to link to and process ACH/eCheck donations.
- Click "Agree and continue" in the box that displays to grant permission for Stripe to connect to your bank account.
- Your account(s) associated with the bank will display. Select the account you want to make your donation with and click Connect Account.
- After you click Link Account, you will see a message stating if your account was successfully connected. Click Continue with America's Charities and then click Confirm Payment to submit your donation for processing.

Maryland Charity Campaign Frequently Asked Questions

1. WHEN DOES THE MARYLAND CHARITY CAMPAIGN (MCC) TAKE PLACE?

The 2026 MCC runs from October 5 to December 11, 2026.

2. WHY SHOULD I CONTRIBUTE THROUGH THE MCC?

The MCC is a convenient, cost-efficient method to donate through the ease of payroll or pension deduction, credit or debit card, or electronic check! The MCC also:

- **Is accountable:** All participating charities have been pre-screened by the Office of the Secretary of State to ensure that they are trustworthy and meet the requirements to participate.
- **Makes a difference:** The community can see the tangible commitment of State employees and retirees and know that their altruism is making an impact across Maryland and beyond.
- **Creates an opportunity:** State employees and retirees may contribute to charitable organizations in a uniform process through one annual campaign.
- **Gives donors the power:** Donors choose the amount and the charity or charities to receive their gifts thus providing donors the opportunity to contribute to one that touches their hearts.
- **Is tax deductible:** All funds given to charities through the MCC are tax deductible. Please check with your tax advisor for further information.
- **Is easy:** Donors can choose how to give: through payroll or pension deduction, a one-time credit or debit card contribution, or a one-time gift by electronic check.

3. ARE PAYROLL DEDUCTION DONATIONS TAKEN FROM PAYCHECKS PRE- OR POST-TAX DEDUCTION?

All payroll deductions are done post-tax deduction, meaning that your taxes are taken out of your paycheck *before* your donation is deducted. In other words, your donations are deducted after your taxes are deducted.

4. WHAT HAPPENS TO UNDESIGNATED CONTRIBUTIONS?

Undesignated contributions are distributed among MCC-participating charities based upon the percentage of the designated funds they receive. If a donor does not designate a charity to receive their donations, meaning a designation is not specified, those funds will be treated as undesignated. Charity write-ins are not permitted; every charity is pre-vetted.

5. WHAT HAPPENS IF A CHARITY I WANT TO GIVE TO ISN'T LISTED?

The Office of the Secretary of State vets every participating charity to determine its eligibility to participate in the MCC. Only those charities listed have been approved to participate in the MCC. Charities that are not listed may not have applied or may not be eligible to participate. You may direct your favorite charity to question and answer #23 regarding applying in the future.

6. HOW DOES A CHARITY BECOME PART OF THE MCC?

Each charity must apply annually and meet the criteria set forth in the Executive Order.

7. IF I CHANGE JOBS WITHIN THE STATE GOVERNMENT, WILL MY PAYROLL DEDUCTION CONTINUE?

8. HOW MUCH MONEY DID THE MCC RAISE LAST YEAR?

In 2025, nearly 4,260 Maryland employees and retirees raised \$1,736,020 through the MCC for nearly 900 worthy causes.

9. WHO ADMINISTERS THE MCC?

The Office of the Secretary of State administers the MCC.

10. WHO PROCESSES MY DONATIONS?

[America's Charities](#), as the Operating Agency, processes all donations.

11. WHAT IS THE MCC'S ADMINISTRATIVE FEE?

The administrative fee for the MCC's Operating Agency is a flat amount established in the contract with the State. The fee is based on a percentage of the actual amount raised in the 2025 Campaign, but cannot exceed 19%, of the prior year's dollars raised, in other words, it cannot exceed \$329,840.

12. DOES THE MCC SET A QUOTA ON CONTRIBUTIONS TO LARGER CHARITIES OR REDIRECT CONTRIBUTIONS TO SMALLER CHARITIES?

No. No quotas for contributions exist for charities of any size, large or small. All contributions designated to eligible charities go to those charities. Undesignated dollars are distributed among the charities based upon a percentage of the designated funds they receive.

13. HOW DOES MY CHARITY RECEIVE ITS CONTRIBUTION?

After the Campaign ends, donations are distributed to charities quarterly either by check or bank transfer.

14. WHAT TAX INFORMATION DO DONORS NEED TO KNOW?

Donors should consult their accountant or tax advisor to answer questions about tax benefits.

15. HOW DO DONORS SIGN UP TO GIVE ONLINE?

This includes Secure Socket Layer (SSL) technology, data encryption, and single sign-on.

- Donors should log into the giving portal and click the "**Your Giving History**" link, located on the home page.

18. WHAT HAPPENS TO DONORS' GIFTS IF A CHARITY THEY PLEDGED TO CLOSSES?

In the event that a charity closes, the donor will be contacted to determine if the pledge should be re-designated, canceled, or reassigned as undesignated. If the gift is reassigned as undesignated, it will be distributed proportionately to all of the charities that received contributions in the Campaign. See #4 for more details.

19. HOW DO DONORS SEARCH FOR A CHARITY?

There are two ways to find a participating charity:

- The donor can log into their online giving account, which can be accessed at <https://mcc.ac-engage.org>.
- The Giving Guide, downloadable from the MCC website [homepage](#), includes a Charity Directory with information on all of the charities that have been approved to participate in the MCC for the current Campaign year.

20. HOW DO DONORS GIVE ONLINE?

21. HOW DO DONORS MAKE CHANGES TO RETIREE PENSION DEDUCTIONS?

If the donor is a retiree and wishes to make changes to their pension deductions, they must contact mcc@charities.org to request their changes.

22. HOW DO CHARITIES ACCESS PLEDGE REPORTS?

Charities should visit the MCC charity page, <https://mcc.maryland.gov/charities/>, for information about pledge reports.

23. HOW DO CHARITIES PARTICIPATE IN FUTURE CAMPAIGNS?

Charities that wish to be notified when the next year's Campaign application is available should complete the 2027 MCC Charity Application Request Form, which can be found on the MCC [charity page](#).

Applications to participate in the MCC are uploaded to the SOS website in December of each calendar year. The Office of the Secretary of State emails the criteria, instructions, and the application to every charity registered with the Office every December.
